EXTREME FIRE DANGER



Current drought conditions have created extremely **dry vegetation** throughout our area, significantly increasing the risk of **fires** caused by fireworks.

BEFORE USING FIREWORKS, PLEASE REMEMBER:



ONLY use fireworks in a safe, legal location.



KEEP fireworks away from dry grass, mulch, brush, and other combustible materials.



HAVE a charged garden hose or fire extinguisher readily available.



NEVER allow children to use fireworks without close adult supervision.



SOAK all used fireworks in water before disposing of them.



NEVER attempt to relight a malfunctioning firework.



BE AWARE of changing weather conditions and wind, which can quickly spread sparks and embers.



EVEN A SINGLE SPARK CAN IGNITE A BRUSH FIRE that threatens homes, businesses, and lives.
